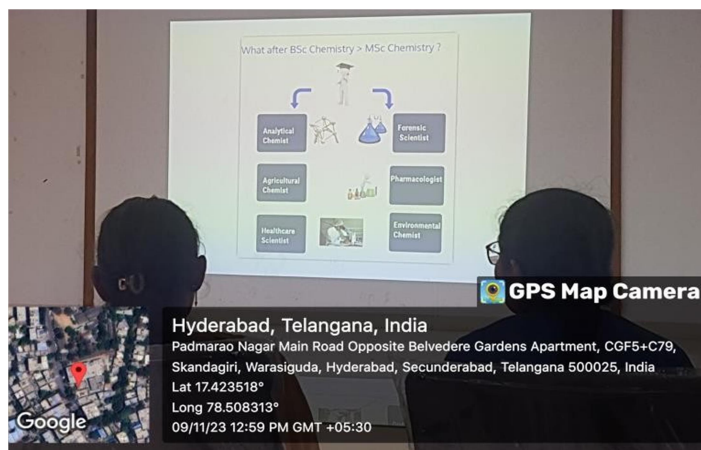


## ACADEMIC FOCUS
